Red Bridge Children's Discipline Policy

It is our desire for children to attend classes and participate in activities in a clean, safe and friendly environment.

Expectations are:

- HONOR God
 - Use appropriate language with inside voices
 - Act in ways that will please HIM
- RESPECT others
 - One voice talking at a time
 - Keep hands and feet to yourself
 - Be kind and polite
- OBEY leaders
 - Follow instructions immediately
 - Encourage others to obey
- RESPECT THE BUILDING
 - Leave electronics/toys at home (cell phones must be kept in pocket/purse)
 - No hats are worn inside
 - Walk inside

When Discipline is needed

In order to fully minister to all the children who attend Red Bridge, it may be necessary to discipline a child who is misbehaving or becoming a danger to someone around them.

Verbal Warning

1 ONE verbal warning given to correct behavior.

2 Suspension.

If a child continues to misbehave, they will be suspended for **one (1) week** from their church attendance privilege. A PHONE CALL will be made to the parent/guardian explaining the situation and will give the date the child may resume attending church again.

After returning from a suspension, the child will meet with designated elder to process behavior/attitude.

After a suspension, we expect your child to behave appropriately for his/her safety and the safety of others.

If misbehavior continues, the discipline process starts over.

After three (3) suspensions, parent/guardian will need to meet with the staff to continue attending church.

Positive behavior will be acknowledged.
